

# Online language support for every child.

School-age children can experience various communication problems. Some children have a language delay or disorder. This can lead to limited vocabulary, difficulty formulating sentences or understanding tasks. Others may have trouble pronouncing sounds, sound combinations or stutter. Other children may have vocal problems.

These problems affect the child's school performance.

## What is TinyEYE Online Language Support?

TinyEYE is the online solution through which children receive live language support in their own (school) environment. They can also practice with unlimited speech-language games after every session.

Support your child's language development in a playful and interactive way!

All speech and language games are adapted to the level of the child.

#### How does it work?

An e-assistant usually accompanies the children during the online sessions. This is someone from the school who helps the children during the session with logging in and using the mouse for example.

The duration of a session is short (15-20 min) and can be planned flexibly. The sessions are adapted to the experience and level of the child.

The language specialist also maintains frequent contact with the parents of the child. Parents/carers and the teacher are involved in the process.

This enables us to work together and plan the optimal treatment based on the specific request for help. This will positively influence the child's school performance. Moreover, the language therapist can use vocabulary themes from class.

TinyEYE follows a continuous learning path, which makes it suitable for toddlers in group 1 to students in group 8.
