

## Special for multilingual children.

“Multilingual children in Group 1 often fall behind on vocabulary compared to children with Dutch as their first language. For example, multilingual children often don't know that a teapot has an ear (the word for spout is oortje in Dutch and it also means ear) or what boertje (in English: burping) means”

This is what we often hear from teachers in schools.

### A program for expanding vocabulary

TinyEYE offers an evidence-based online program for expanding the receptive (word comprehension) and productive (word use) vocabulary for multilingual children.

The TinyEYE program is carried out by experienced speech and language therapists. These specialists are trained and experienced in working online with children with a language deficiency.

### Unlimited and free homework environment

It is important to keep practicing outside of the sessions. Children and their parents, but also teachers, have access to an online homework environment in which they can play language games independently.

The language specialist also leaves instructional videos and personal messages in the homework.

### How does it work?

The TinyEYE language specialist works online with unique language games to expand the vocabulary in a playful and visual way.

During the live online sessions, the TinyEYE specialist works with tailor-made language games suitable for children from 4 years and older.

### Costs

Online speech therapy is fully covered by the Dutch health insurances for children up to the age of 18.
